TOWN OF SPARTA A PROPOSED LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 2023 ENTITLED "PERMITTING TOWN EMPLOYEES TO LAWFULLY CONCEAL CARRY"

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Sparta as follows:

SECTION I. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

The Town of Sparta, through its Town Board and in its proprietary capacity, declares that it is necessary, for the security, safety, protection and well-being of its employees and its property and individuals present thereupon, to allow its current employees whom are in possession of a valid New York State Pistol Permit, to possess and bear firearms while entering into and being present in and on, buildings and structures, motorized vehicles, properties which are owned, leased and operated by the Town of Sparta.

SECTION II. PROOF OF VALID NEW YORK STATE PISTOL PERMIT

Any Town of Sparta current employee whom is desirous of physically carrying a firearm into, or within Town of Sparta owned properties, buildings & structures, motorized vehicles, shall produce a valid NYS pistol permit and a list of firearms complete with serial numbers. A copy of the permit shall be maintained in the employees personnel file and any changes or revocations shall be immediately reported to the Town of Sparta Supervisor and Town Board.

SECTION III. PENALTIES

Failure to comply with this local law shall be punishable by confinement in the Livingston County Jail for a term not to exceed three (3) months and a fine not to exceed Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00).

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
